



# MULTIPLE STORE VIEW PRICING FOR MAGENTO 2

## INSTALLATION GUIDE



A link to download the extension will be sent to your email shortly after your order is successfully placed.

For Magento 2 Multiple Store View Pricing extension, there are many options (both CE and EE) for you to download; hence, you should select the suitable extension version based on your Magento version and edition.

It is extremely important to install the right extension because you can avoid conflicts during the usage period.

**For example:** if you are using Magento 2.1.x - Community edition, then you install the module v2.1.2.

Then, follow these 6 steps to install the extension:

**Step 1:**

Unzip the file.

**Step 2:**

Create 4 new directories as below:

+ **app/code/Bss/MultiStoreViewPricing**

+ **app/code/Bss/MultiStoreViewPricingCatalogRule**

+ **app/code/Bss/MultiStoreViewPricingPriceIndexer**

+ **app/code/Bss/MultiStoreViewPricingTierPrice**

In which:

**MultiStoreViewPricing**, **MultiStoreViewPricingCatalogRule**, **MultiStoreViewPricingPriceIndexer**, **MultiStoreViewPricingTierPrice** are the 4 modules' internal identifiers which can be found in the "[composer.json](#)" file of the downloaded compressed file. (Please see node "psr-4").

This is what you call the directory, and then you put the contents of the extension ZIP file in there.

**\*NOTE:** Magento 2 Multiple Store View Pricing extension includes 4 small modules; hence; you need to install these 4 modules together.

**Step 3:**

Upload all of 4 above directories to the root directory of your Magento installation. The root directory of Magento is the directory that contains the directories "app", "bin", "lib" and more. All directories should match the existing directory structure.

**Step 4:**

Go to Magento 2 root directory. Enter command line: `php bin/magento:setup:upgrade`.

**Step 5:**

Enter command line: `php bin/magentosetup:static-content:deploy.`

**Step 6:** Clear all Caches.
